

## Visiting Faculty Position in the Department of Environmental Studies, Ashoka University (August 2021 to May 2022)

The Department of Environmental Studies at Ashoka University invites applications for one Visiting Faculty (open-rank) position for the [Monsoon 2021 and Spring 2022 semesters](#) from 14 August 2021 to 15 May 2022.

We encourage applications from outstanding scholars in **environmental sciences**, which includes ecology, earth and atmospheric sciences, environmental chemistry, and remote sensing, and in **environmental policy and law**. Candidates with substantial teaching experience will be preferred.

The successful candidate will be expected to teach **two** courses per semester. One is the compulsory Environmental Studies Foundation Course, taught to incoming undergraduates who may not have a science background. This Foundation Course will have around 100 students.

The second course will be an elective offered to a smaller class (up to 30 students) of more senior undergraduates.

The Department includes both scholars of the natural sciences and the humanities and social sciences, and aims to foster quality interdisciplinary research scholarship.

Ashoka University strongly encourages applications by women and members of SC/ST/OBC and other groups underrepresented in academia.

Applicants should submit: 1) cover letter; 2) a curriculum vitae; 3) two samples of academic writings (article length); 4) teaching evaluations (if available); 5) two confidential letters of reference

Note: The Ashoka job portal further asks for statements of teaching philosophy for all applications.
