Tenure-track Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor in International Relations

The Department of International Relations at Ashoka University invites applications for two open rank positions in International Relations.

Scholars would need to have a doctorate in International Relations, International Politics, International Political Economy, and/or International History with a focus on IR. All candidates will be required to demonstrate:

- (a) **Teaching experience** in the broader fields mentioned above at the Undergraduate and Graduate levels. However, the candidate will be expected to teach survey and introductory courses in different aspects of International Relations, no matter what their field of specialisation.
- (b) **A strong publication record**. Candidates applying for the position of an Assistant Professor would be expected to have published at least one article in a peer-reviewed journal. They would also need to demonstrate evidence of a book manuscript (single authored) in press or close to completion. Those applying for the position of an Associate Professor will need to demonstrate evidence of at least 3 published articles in peer-reviewed journals and a published book (single authored). Those applying for the post of Professor will be expected to have at least 6 published articles in peer-reviewed journals, one published book, and the second under review or in press (both works ought to be single authored). **Note:** If a candidate does not have the required publication record, she/he will be expected to demonstrate very strong evidence of teaching, administrative skills and responsibilities, grant-making experience, and overall entrepreneurship.
- (c) **Evidence of grants and funds** that a candidate might have applied for, please mention both successful and unsuccessful research bids.
- (d) **Evidence of 'Good Citizenry'**, ways and methods in which a candidate might have played a role outside of teaching within the broader Academy and/or society.
- (e) **Evidence of administrative experience** within or outside of academia.

Ashoka is a research university based near New Delhi, India. It offers internationally competitive terms and conditions. The teaching load is comparable to the top universities in the world, and the University supports research in various ways. Ashoka University strongly encourages applications by women and members of other groups underrepresented in academia.

Applicants should submit, among other things, a cover letter of not more than 750 words.
