This position is open to candidates at any level – assistant, associate, and full professor. Successful candidates are expected to have a commitment to teaching excellence and to research productivity in psychological science. At Ashoka, we emphasize psychology as an empirical science. We anticipate making two offers. The faculty hired will help shape the psychology department, in addition to offering basic courses (e.g., introductory psychology, statistics, research methods, critical thinking seminars), and/or teaching a core course in clinical/social/cognitive psychology, as well as elective courses within their areas of expertise.

Candidates are expected to have a PhD, but candidates nearing the completion of their doctorate will also be considered.
